Goldthorn Park Reception Spring Term 2022

Welcome back

Welcome back after the Christmas break. We hope that you all had an enjoyable holiday! Spring term will begin with our new topic - 'I Wonder What is cold?' 1. We will use this as a basis for planning each area of the curriculum where possible. Our learning will see us learn about our immediate environment, what changes occur in winter and spring and life on the farm. Our work will include storytelling, model making and critical thinking. We will also be learning about celebrations including Chinese New Year and Easter. Our learning takes place though a mix of adult led and child initiated sessions indoors and outdoors. The children guide our learning wherever possible.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Through the PSHE lessons and all areas of the Early Years curriculum, your children will develop their skills surrounding managing themselves, self-regulation and building relationships. As well as separate PSHEe lessons, children will use stories and Circle Time to explore their thoughts, feelings and emotions.

Communication and Language

Across the curriculum, children will develop their speaking, listening and attention and understanding skills. They will listen attentively to stories, learn to follow instructions accurately and will learn to express themselves appropriately. They will also learn new words and begin speaking in full sentences.

Children will build upon their Autumn phonic knowledge and continue learning new phonemes as well as being introduced to new Common Exception Words

Children will continue to consolidate their learning from Phonics into their Literacy work by developing their writing skills through practising letter

formation, word building and beginning to write sentences. The children will continue to be supported in their reading through whole class story time, whole class reading and individual reading. This is all consolidated through Child-Initiated learning

Mathematics

In Reception, the children will continue developing their understanding of numbers to 10 through subitising and composition. They will practise counting in different patterns and will recognise numbers in their written form. They will begin to learn to number bonds to 5 and 10 and recall number facts.. The children will also learn about 3D shapes and will make comparisons between different measures. Much

of our mathematical work will be practical, using apparatus such as cubes and small toys. This is all consolidated through

Through all their learning, children will develop their knowledge of Past and Present, Culture and Communities and The Natural World and Through our topic, we will learn about the changes that occur during winter and spring as well as life on the farm.

Children will continue to have homework that will share the sounds being learnt in school and a discussions or short task to support and guide you with their learning



within lessons. This will continue to be a creative activity alongside home school reading.
