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| <p>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</p> <p>Through all areas of the curriculum, children will develop their skills surrounding making relationships, self-confidence and awareness and managing feelings and behaviour. They will develop the confidence to try new activities and will take into account others' ideas.</p> | <p>Communication and Language</p> <p>Through all areas of the curriculum, children will develop their speaking, listening and attention and understanding skills. They will learn to listen attentively in a range of situations, learn to follow instructions accurately and will learn to express themselves clearly.</p> |
| <p>Literacy</p> <p>The children will build upon their sound and word knowledge and apply this in their writing. They will continue to build words and sentences forming letters accurately as well as using their phonic skills, common exception words and punctuation. Story writing over the summer term will support this development. Children will continue to take home reading books including both fiction and non-fiction books. Comprehension focus will be developed with the children through their independent and class reading.</p> | <p>Mathematics</p> <p>Children will continue to count reliably with numbers from 1 to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number. Using quantities and objects, they will add and subtract two single digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer. They will develop their problem solving skills, including doubling, halving and sharing. They will also solve problems using time and distance and will compare quantities and objects. They will develop their mathematical language to describe properties of 3D shapes and apply this knowledge across learning.</p> |
| <p>Physical Development</p> <p>Children receive a taught session of PE each week and have daily access to our outdoor classroom, allowing their gross motor skills to be refined. The children will also develop their fine motor skills by taking part in daily finger gym activities.</p> | <p>Understanding the World</p> <p>Through all areas of the curriculum, especially topic, children will develop their knowledge of People and Communities, The World and Technology. They will enjoy relating their experiences to those they are learning about and explore similarities and differences between experiences and traditions.</p> |
| <p>Homework</p> <p>We will continue to send out the purple homework books. This will consolidate what the children have learned in class. Please read with your child every day and sign your child's home reading record.</p> | <p>Expressive Arts and Design</p> <p>Through all areas of the curriculum, children will develop their skills by exploring and using different media and materials and by being imaginative. They will represent their own ideas by singing songs, making music, dancing and experimenting with ways of changing them. The children will safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and functions.</p> <p>RE will be taught through all of our areas, especially PSED and Understanding of the World.</p> |
