Maths

We will be continuing to focus heavily upon our times tables. Children will also practice number bonds to 10, 100 and 1000 as well as continuing with the development of their times tables knowledge. We will continue to use our four-rule calculations knowledge as well as learning new skills linked to decimals, time and money. We will also be looking at shapes and statistics.

PE

This term, the children will be taught a range of skills with Soccer 2000! We aim to try and get outside as much as possible.

RE

The children will be learning about the five pillars of Islam later in the summer term after finishing - inspirational leaders.

Art

Our Art learning will allow children the opportunity to work with a range of resources to create amazing artwork!
We will look at famous artists and discuss their 'style.'

History

In History we will be using different resources to investigate and explore the past. We hope to have an exciting workshop for this topic! 😊

English

This term English will focus on stories with dilemmas.
We will start with 'Grandad and the Laundry Basket.' This is a short video clip story and we look forward to delving deeper into the story! Following on from this story spinner, we will be looking at writing persuasively.
Our daily starters in English will continue to focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar.

Science

In Science, the children will continue their learning on electricity before moving on to Animals: including humans!

MFL

In Year 4, the children will continue to learn French. We will be looking at animals, including pets and zoo animals. Children will also be learning to name different types of clothing.

DT

Our DT learning will be linked to our thematic learning of 'Meet the Greeks'. We will look at a recipe of ingredients and hopefully be able to create our own dish!

Geography

In Geography we will be learning about different weather and climates. We will also look at features of a map.

Computing

The children will continue to retrieve and save information linked to our topic. We will use a range of programmes to further our learning.



Music

Children will have the opportunity to listen to a range of musical genres and learn to understand the meaning of different musical vocabulary. They will also have a teacher from the Wolverhampton Music School to help them learn to play a musical instrument – the violin.
